Dine Out for the Cure is a turnkey fundraising event, a day where local restaurants and food truck vendors unite with Komen LA supporters to help raise awareness and funds to fight against breast cancer.

In LA County alone, approximately 6,000 new cases of breast cancer are diagnosed each year. Tragically, LA County loses approximately 1,000 patients a year to the disease.


Susan G. Komen is the world's largest breast cancer organization, funding more breast cancer research than any other nonprofit while providing real-time help to those facing the disease. Komen has set a Bold Goal to reduce the current number of breast cancer deaths by 50 percent in the U.S. by 2026. Since its founding in 1982, Komen has funded more than \$988 million in research and provided \$2.2 billion in funding to screening, education, treatment and psychological support programs serving millions of people in more than 60 countries worldwide. Komen was founded by Nancy G. Brinker, who promised her sister, Susan G. Komen, that she would end the disease that claimed Suzy's life. Komen Research

Komen's research focus has evolved over the years. In the beginning, we focused on understanding the basic biology of breast cancer. As we learn more about the factors that make cancer cells grow and spread, we have been able to invest more in the translation of this knowledge into treatment, early detection and prevention, with the goal of supporting work that has significant potential to lead to reductions in incidence and mortality within the decade. As the global leader in the fight against breast cancer, we strive to identify the best science around the world. We are proud to fund research in the United States and across the globe.



Serving the Community in LA County



Seventy-five percent of the Affiliate's net income funds grants to local hospitals and community organizations that provide breast health education and breast cancer screening and treatment programs for medically underserved women. The remaining net income (a minimum of 25 percent) supports the national research program, which funds groundbreaking breast cancer research, meritorious awards, and educational and scientific programs around the world.

Getting diagnosed: Komen is the only organization providing uninsured women with access to diagnostics including diagnostic mammograms (women of all ages); biopsies; MRIs/Ultrasounds and more.

Free services for living: No other organization provides an uninsured woman and her family with care across the entire spectrum of life: navigation through our complex medical system; meal delivery; temporary financial help for the entire length of her treatment; free surgery and chemotherapy; lymphedema compression garments and more.

Researching the Causes and the Treatments: Next to the U.S. government, Komen is the largest funder of breast cancer research in the world. Every piece of progress has been touched by a Komen grant.

Programs for specific population in need: Komen LA County designs, implements and executes culturally relevant programs to address the unique needs of priority populations including African Americans, Latinas and those living with Metastatic Breast Cancer (stage IV).
